



SEASONAL PLANNING & CARE

SPRING



- **Cutback:** Once the lawn is producing new growth, mow low, removing as much of the leaf as possible. Do not cut into the runners or expose bare dirt.



- **Topdress:** After the cutback, evenly throw out a granular wetting agent. Then topdress with Rocket Topdress at 10mm depth across the lawn. Water in well. After the first water, 50% of the topdress should disappear. This will rehydrate, feed and fix unevenness in the lawn. This can be done at anytime during the growing season. Watering daily after topdressing will get you mowing a week later.



- **Mowing:** Mowing should start 7 days after topdressing. Mow every 7 days as the weather warms. Sir Walter Buffalo is best kept between 25-40mm. Mow as soon as the grass reaches the desired height – this will stop the mower from scalping the lawn



- **Fertilising:** Apply LSA Lawn Fertiliser every 6 weeks. Use slow-release granular fertilisers at label rates.



- **Watering:** Water deeply (soaking the top 100mm of soil) initially. After this, your lawn will require watering at least once a week with a minimum of 20mm of water at a time.

SUMMER



- **Mowing:** Maintain mowing every 7 days. Ensure your blades are sharp to prevent tearing the leaf blades.



- **Fertilising:** Apply LSA Lawn Fertiliser every 8 weeks, following label directions.



- **Pest Control:** Apply Acepelryn GR or LSA Grub Guard Ultimate for season long control.



- **Watering:** Water twice per week with a minimum of 20mm of water at a time, early in the morning. During periods of extreme heat, you will need to add an extra water day to your schedule.

AUTUMN



- **Mowing:** As temperatures begin to cool, gradually let the grass grow a little taller (up to 50mm heading into winter).



- **Fertilising:** Apply your final granular feed, we recommend Oxafert, in March to strengthen the root system for winter and reduce weeds.



- **Colour:** Applying ColourGuard Plus before you lose growth will ensure your lawn stays green throughout the winter months. This also offers the addition of essential nutrients for the plant.

WINTER



- **Mowing:** Growth slows right down. You only need to mow once every 2 to 3 weeks just to trim the tips and keep the lawn neat. Always use a catcher during this time.



- **Fertilising:** Do not apply nitrogen. Instead, apply Iron Guard Plus in June or July to enhance winter colour.



- **Watering:** Reduce watering significantly. Only irrigate if the lawn is severely drying out.
